

Short guidelines for biogeography presentation

Recommendations

1. Make a Power Point presentation about each of the two papers. There are multiple resources in Internet with a title like “How to read a scientific/research paper” (like <http://www.google.com/search?q=how+to+read+scientific+research+paper>) which could be of some help.
2. Try not to exceed 8 slides per paper. Typically, every slide requires 2 min (or sometimes less) of explanation therefore you will fit in 15 min presentation (30 min total).
3. Use light theme, if possible.
4. Your presentation should emphasize: (1) what is this paper about? (2) what are main discoveries/achievements of this paper? (3) what do you think author(s) of paper did not do?
5. Do not forget to address everything which is on the slide, and if there are any names of organism, illustrate them with image.
